

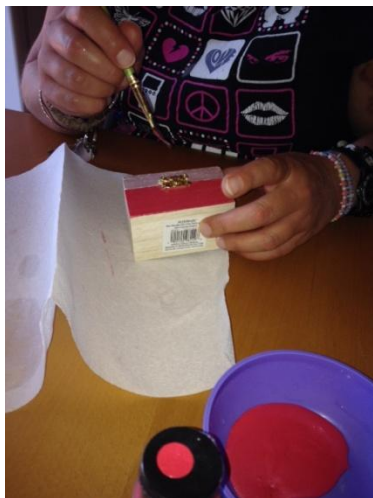
Independent Living Association: Creative Arts Consortium
